PURPOSE: The Response -Ability Pregnant and Parenting Program serves pregnant and/or parenting homeless and

tenuously housed youth through our 120 -day interim s helter and supportive services program .

PARTICIPANTS: Teen moms, ages 14 -19, who are homeless, and who are pregnant or parenting

PROGRAM: Builds trusting relationships and a curriculum for young women, young fathers, and their

extended families facing the difficult challenges of t een parenthood and homelessness Provides housing and supportive services at Open Door Youth Shelter —Lakeview Provides case management services and social services to participants in their community

(home, school, and other locations as needed)

SERVICES: Professional staff addresses client needs, including:

Housing Public aid

Medical and mental health

Vocational training

Connections to education opportunities Family life and parenting education

Daycare

Life skills (selfesteem, budgeting, and more)

Support groups

PROGRAM Reduce subsequent pregnancies

GOALS: Increase safety and stability of housing

Improve family health and functioning

Increase educational attainment
