## Where We Help

**We provide services to individuals and families, in locations throughout the city. For more information, scan the QR code.**



**Street Medicine Team:** travels to sites across the city, Monday through Saturday.

**Harold Washington Library:** drop in hours offered on Mondays for access to case workers and health/mental health care.

**Health Outreach Bus:** brings medical care and community to underserved areas of Chicago, Sunday through Thursday.

**CTA Outreach:** connects with unhoused individuals at public transit locations, providing essential resources.

## What We Offer

**Case Workers:** Help with housing, shelters, rehab centers, navigating government programs, and practical advice.

**Harm Reduction:** Harm reduction kits with safe use supplies, substance use treatment referrals, and behavioral health support available.

**Health Care:** Basic medical care; Blood pressure & blood sugar checks; Referrals for medical and dental care; Wound care, medications and chronic conditions.

**Human Connection:** Conversation, connections, food, water and basic supplies.

For shelter placements and interim basic services	Visit the Shelter Placement and Resource Center (SPARC) at 2241 S. Halsted Street. SPARC is a 24-hour intake shelter for adults. Drop in or call <b>3-1-1</b> to check bed availability.
