Where We Help

We provide services to individuals and families, in locations throughout the city. For more information, scan the QR code.



Street Medicine Team: travels to sites across the city, Monday through Saturday.

Harold Washington Library: drop in hours offered on Mondays for access to case workers and health/mental health care.

Health Outreach Bus: brings medical care and community to underserved areas of Chicago, Sunday through Thursday.

CTA Outreach: connects with unhoused individuals at public transit locations, providing essential resources.

What We Offer

Case Workers: Help with housing, shelters, rehab centers, navigating government programs, and practical advice.

Harm Reduction: Harm reduction kits with safe use supplies, substance use treatment referrals, and behavioral health support available.

Health Care: Basic medical care; Blood pressure & blood sugar checks; Referrals for medical and dental care; Wound care, medications and chronic conditions.
