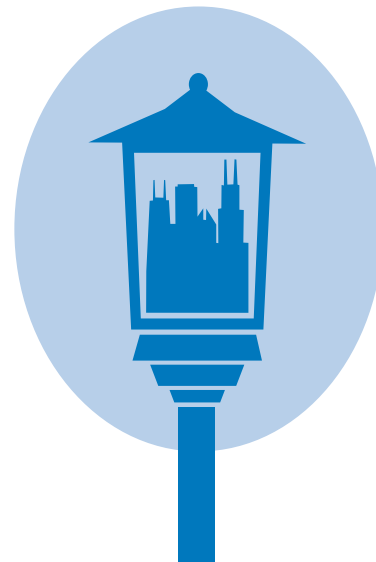

Financials FY2025

July 1, 2024–June 30, 2025

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

In fiscal year 2025, total revenue decreased by \$500K from the prior fiscal year. The agency realized a drop in year-over-year bequest and estate gifts. Due to market changes, there was a reduction in investment income, which contributed to the decline. Revenue increased in all other areas.

In fiscal year 2025, total program expense remained stable from the prior fiscal year. TNM redesigned its Pathways Program, shifting from a congregate setting to a scattered site model of care for youth living in Long-Term Residential Housing in the community. The redesign increased the number of bed nights from 14,475 to 15,030 for fiscal year 2025.

TNM's endowment grew by \$600K in fiscal year 2025, ending with a balance of \$7.5M. TNM relied on community-based philanthropy from individuals, foundations, corporations, civic groups, and congregations to support outreach, health, and youth housing.

Through the generosity of 4,277 donors, private contributions for fiscal year 2025 totaled \$6.5M. Additionally, TNM gained 950 new financial supporters.

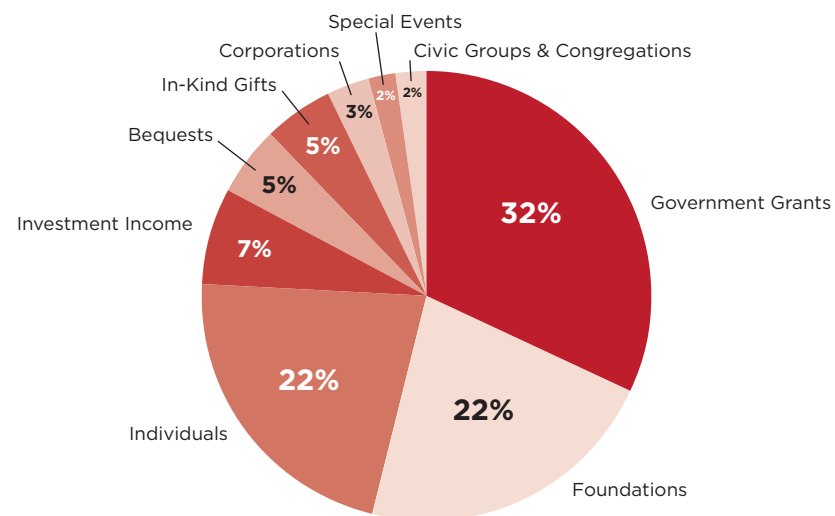

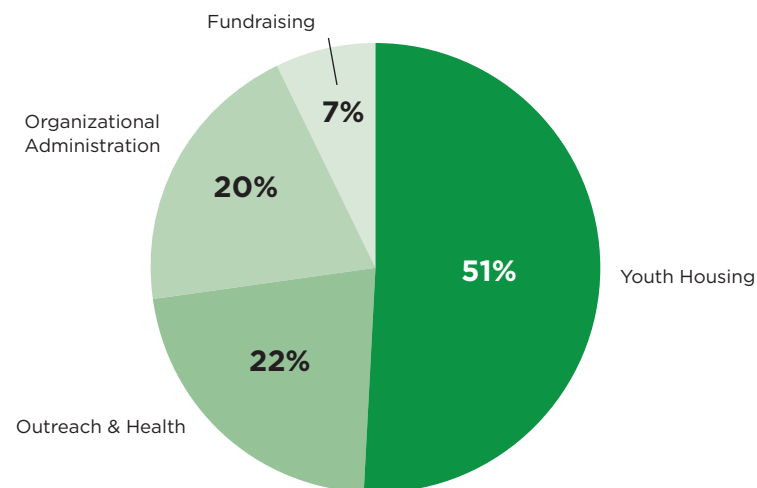
